



Effective November 12, 2020, The Gratz Bank has temporarily closed the lobbies at all branches in an effort to protect the health of employees, customers and community against the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Pennsylvania is experiencing the largest surge in daily new coronavirus cases since the pandemic first began back in March. All counties in which the Bank operates have been designated as having “substantial” community transmission of COVID-19.

While the Bank’s lobbies will be closed to the public until further notice, customers can still use drive-up windows, night depositories, ATMs, online and mobile banking, and telephone banking. Customers requiring additional bank services or loans are encouraged to call their local branch to schedule an appointment.
